Trade Offs to Consider

- Higher price compared to basic models
- Corded design limits mobility
- Requires regular filter replacements
- Heavier than handheld vacuums
- Limited to specific surface types
- More complex maintenance routine
- Slower cleaning speed on large areas

How It Compares

- Better filtration than basic bagged vacuums
- More suction power than handheld models
- Worse maneuverability than cordless options
- Higher cost than entry-level canister vacuums
- Similar weight to mid-range bagged vacuums
- Better air quality results than non-filtration models
- Less flexibility for large open spaces
